SharedGeo is a federally recognized 501 (c) 3 nonprofit founded in September 2008 with the mission to help government, nonprofit, education, and corporate entities use mapping technologies and share geographic data for the public good. SharedGeo's initial focus was on disaster response and relief operations in the United States, but it has since become engaged in a wide variety of related activities – including environmental, public safety and specialized software development. Many of its employees donate their time – which allows SharedGeo to keep its expenses low and use incoming revenues to develop additional products which benefit the public. Some of its current and past clients include the nation's largest professional geospatial association focused on infrastructure, the Geospatial Information & Technology Association (www.gita.org), U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service, Iowa Department Homeland Security and Emergency Management, Range (www.rangeresources.com), Minnesota Department of Transportation, and Airborne Data Systems (www.airbornedatasystems.com). It is also the administrative home to one of the world's 21 software programs sanction by the Open Source Geospatial Foundation (OSGeo), GeoMOOSE (www.geomoose.com), which since 2008 has been used by hundreds of units of government around the world to share their geospatial data with the public.
